- Science: We learned about volcanoes and how they can change the Earth's surface. Ask your child about our volcano experiment we completed in class.
- Math: This week we started our new unit called Ages and Timelines. This unit is increasing our subtraction knowledge by using the open number line. We have developed strategies to subtract numbers such as using a landmark number, breaking apart numbers, subtracting 10 and adding more, etc.
- Writing: Throughout this week Team Ronzio has been completing experiments. We have been working with others to ask a questions, form a hypothesis, develop a step by step procedure, record our observations, and draw conclusions. In order to show our experiment and results, we will be creating posters that include all of our steps and even pictures of our experiments.
- Reading: In shared reading we discussed the importance of accessing our background knowledge before, during, and after reading a book. In reading groups, we have been focusing on nonfiction elements and why they are important/help readers. In read aloud we are reading a book from the Magic Tree House series called *Thanksgiving* on Thursday.
