What We've Been Boing

Below are the units we will be focusing on throughout the next couple of weeks.

- Science: We began our new science unit of the Earth's surface by talking about the ratio of land verses water. We also discusses the natural forms of water that are on Earth (oceans, streams, rivers, ponds, lakes, seas, etc.)
- * Math: This week we started a new unit over equal groups. This unit involves repeated addition, arrays, and solving word problems by drawing pictures and arrays to show math thinking.
- Writing: Personal Narratives. We are getting close to the end of our personal narrative unit. Students have edited a couple works of writing and will be publishing one story in the computer lab next week.
- * Reading: In shared reading we are working on problem solving unfamiliar words that we come across while reading. Students have practiced the strategies of reading on, using context clues, rereading, using details, and asking for help. We have been finishing up the DRAs and have been reading on the iPads with myON reader.
- * <u>Social Studies</u>: This week we have been discussing and practicing what it means to work well with others. We also started talking about what it means to be a good friend.
- <u>Word Study</u>: In word study we have been working with beginning blends. Students have been reading poems to identify the beginning blends they hear and see in common words. We have also been focusing on nouns and proper nouns.
