

## What We've Been Doing



- Science: We are enjoying our new science unit on the Earth's surface. We have discussed the difference between dirt and soil. On Monday we dug up dirt from around Paxton and compared it to potting soil. We also learned how wind, water, and ice can affect the Earth's surface (erosion).
- \* Math: This week we finished our equal groups unit and started our place value unit.
  Our place value unit is called "Grandma Eudora's T-shirt Factory." We are using rolls of 10 t-shirts and loose shirts to understand place value.
- \* <u>Writing</u>: We finished our personal narrative unit. On Monday students worked very hard on completing a post-unit writing prompt. Throughout the rest of the week we worked in the library lap top lab to publish our stories in Microsoft Word.
- \* Reading: In shared reading we learned various strategies to help us summarize and retell text and stories that we read. Students were able to restate what they read, take notes on their book, combine related information across pages and chapters of their book, and distinguish between important and non-important ideas. We started reading groups again. Ask your child what book they are reading.
- \* Word Study: In word study we have continued working with beginning blends. Students have been sorting words, using iPad applications to study and spell words, and created spider blends (we hope you enjoyed the spider decorations at our brown bag lunch!)
